Assist in the supervision of youth while on excursions. Maintain a positive environment for program participants.

Perform other duties as assigned.



# **Our Program**

The Teen Leader Program allows teens the opportunity to work side by side with Recreation Staff in the City's two youth summer camps, three Active Kids after school programs and other City events.
