






-  Major fault traces as mapped by Morton, 1999. Presumed active, except where shown otherwise based on geological studies.

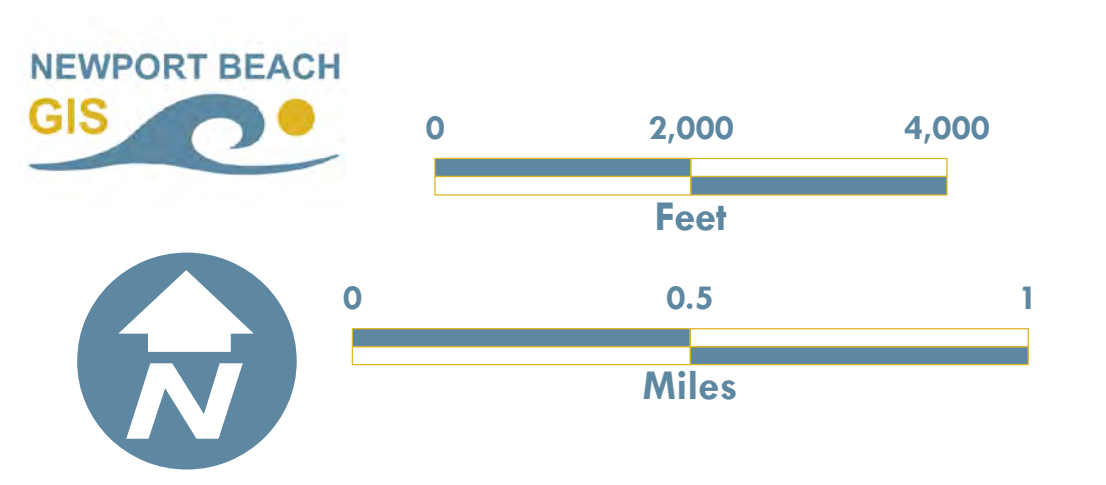
