ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

AUTHORIZATION: Established by Resolution No. 2012-116 adopted on

November 27, 2012.

MEMBERSHIP: Seven members appointed by the City Council reflecting

geographical diversity within the City, and two non-voting Council Members appointed by the Mayor, confirmed by the City Council. The Mayor will also appoint one of the two non-voting Council Members for an annual term as Chair of

the Committee.

TERM: The seven members appointed by the City Council shall

serve a four year term, with a limit of two consecutive terms. Council Member appointees shall serve a one year term.

Appointments shall occur in January.

MEETINGS: Meetings shall occur at a regular time and place as called by

the Chair.

BROWN ACT: This Committee shall be subject to the Ralph M. Brown Act,

or any successor regulation.

PURPOSE & RESPONSIBILITIES:

It shall be the duty of the Environmental Quality Affairs Committee to:

- A. Advise the City Council on policies, programs and projects that improve or detract from the environmental quality of the City, as requested by the City Council;
- B. Comment on Notices of Preparation, as requested by the City Council; and
- C. Advise on any matter referred to the Environmental Quality Affairs Committee by the City Council or City Manager.
