Grant Howald Park Rehabilitation Project

ABOUT THIS PROJECT

Grant Howald Park is a 3.1 acre park that has been serving the community since 1954 and a popular community destination. In order to continue serving the community at the highest level, it is necessary to rehabilitate our City facilities. The Grant Howald Park Rehabilitation Project will be focused on upgrading the athletic field for usability throughout the year, replacing the playground equipment to encourage more integrated play, and beautifying the Fifth Avenue frontage. A preliminary conceptual design is being developed by RJM Design Group, with input from City staff and the Parks, Beaches and Recreation Commission ad hoc committee. However, we look forward to receiving the community's input to ensure that this project rehabilitates the park with amenities that meet the residents' expectations and reflects the community's charm.

BENEFITS

This rehabilitation will provide year-round turf play opportunities, new playground equipment, more seating and gathering areas and the beautification of the Fifth Avenue frontage.

IMPACTS

Construction will be scheduled in multiple phases to minimize inconvenience to residents. More specific information will be available once the project enters the construction phase.
