SR-55/Newport Boulevard Improvement Study 5:30 to 7:30 p.m on Wednesday, Sept.14, 2011

The Orange County Transportation Authority and the cities of Costa Mesa and Newport Beach are working to identify potential transportation improvements to SR-55/Newport Boulevard from 19th Street to Industrial Way. At the terminus of the Costa Mesa Freeway, at 19th Street, close to 100,000 vehicles pass through this area on a daily basis, and these volumes are projected to grow in the future.

OCTA's SR-55 Access Study, completed in 2008, analyzed seven design concepts and recommended four alternatives for further study. These four alternatives were chosen for their ability to best accommodate movements of cars, buses and pedestrians. As a continuation of the Access Study, OCTA and its partner cities have begun the SR-55/Newport Boulevard Improvement Study to further analyze and refine the four alternatives.
