



FLOOD MAPS AND INSURANCE

Community Meeting

Dear Property Owner:

The City of Newport Beach, Community Development Department will be hosting a community meeting regarding the revised Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM), which affects flood insurance requirements. The Federal Emergency Management Association (FEMA) updated the FIRM for the City of Newport Beach as well as other Orange County cities. As a result, some properties in the City are now designated to be in Special Flood Hazard Areas (SFHA). Properties located in SFHA may be required to carry flood insurance by the properties mortgage lender.

Representatives from FEMA will be attending the meeting to discuss flood insurance requirements. Property owners and other parties interested in public information relating to the flood mapping, its impact on development, and flood insurance requirements are encouraged to attend.
