Open Enrollment for Plan Year 2021

Dear City of Newport Beach Retiree,

Open Enrollment is just around the corner! Please take note of the following information:

- You must complete and return the enclosed City of Newport Beach Retiree Election Form no later than October 16, 2020. We've included a self-addressed envelope for your convenience. Forms mav also be submitted via fax to (949) 644-3305 or email to HRBenefit@newportbeachca.gov. A fillable form can be found in the Retiree Corner located at https://www.newportbeachca.gov/government/departments/human-resources/virtual-health-fair. Fillable forms will need to be printed and returned via mail, fax or email.
- Open Enrollment is September 21 through October 16, 2020, with changes effective January 1, 2021.
- You must contact CalPERS directly, by phone or online, for changes to your CalPERS health plan enrollment(s) including adding or deleting coverage for yourself and eligible dependents.
- The 2021 CalPERS health plan contribution is \$143 which is paid directly to CalPERS on your behalf and applied towards the cost of your medical insurance premium. Hybrid Retiree Health Savings (RHS) plan participants receive the remaining balance of the monthly City contribution into their RHS account.
- The City is transitioning from Cigna dental and MES Vision to MetLife for both coverages. Enrollment changes to dental and vision plans can only be made if you are a current member of the dental or vision plan. Please review the enclosed benefit charts for new MetLife plan information.
- The City's annual Health and Wellness Fair is moving to a virtual platform and will be available Monday, September 28, through Friday, October 16, 2020 on the City of Newport Beach website.
