NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the legislative body of the City, or any member or members thereof authorized by the body, or any individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations, may file a written argument, not to exceed 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, for or against the City measure.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and sample ballots for the election, the City Clerk has fixed **Tuesday**, **January 4**, **2022 at 5:30 p.m.** as the date after which no arguments for or against the City measure may be submitted to the City Clerk for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in Article 4. Arguments shall be submitted to the City Clerk, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, at City Hall, 100 Civic Center Drive (Bay E, 2nd Floor), Newport Beach, California. Arguments may be changed or withdrawn until, and including, the date fixed by the City Clerk.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any impartial analysis or direct argument filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk's Office for not less than 10-calendar days with the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis. Any rebuttal argument filed under the authority of the California Elections Code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk's Office for not less than 10-calendar days from the deadline for filing rebuttal arguments (**4:30 p.m. on Friday, January 14, 2022**).
