SIDE LETTER OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH

AND

THE NEWPORT BEACH POLICE ASSOCIATION

This Side Letter of Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into this <u>29</u> day of <u>Novern Bara</u> 2022, by and between the City of Newport Beach ("City") and the Newport Beach Police Association ("NBPA") (collectively "Parties") with respect to the following:

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2021, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2021-129 approving a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between the Parties with a term of July 1, 2021, through November 30, 2025;

WHEREAS, given increases in the cost of medical insurance and to aid in the recruitment and retention of valuable employees, the Parties wish to modify the MOU; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement will not have the effect of an agreement, and will not be binding on either party, until it is ratified by the affected bargaining unit and approved by the City Council.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, it is mutually agreed between the Parties as follows:

- 1. The following language in Section 4.A.2. Fringe Benefits, Insurance, Medical Insurance, of the MOU is amended to read as follows:
 - 2. Medical Insurance
 - b. City Contribution

Current Language:

i. The City's monthly contribution towards the Cafeteria Plan is \$1,524.00 (plus the minimum CalPERS participating employer contribution as outlined in Government Code section 22892.)

Amended Language:

i. The City's monthly contribution towards the Cafeteria Plan is \$1,524.00 (plus the minimum CalPERS participating employer's contribution as outlined in Government Code section 22892.) Temporary Increase. Effective the pay period that includes January 1, 2023, the City's monthly contribution towards the Cafeteria Plan increases to \$1,624.00 (plus the minimum CalPERS participating employer's contribution as outlined in Government Code section 22892). Effective the pay period that includes January 1, 2025, the City's monthly contribution towards the Cafeteria Plan decreases to \$1,524.00 (plus the minimum CalPERS participating employer's contribution as outlined in Government Code section 22892).

2. Except as expressly modified herein, all other provisions, terms, and covenants set forth in the MOU shall remain unchanged and shall be in full force and effect.
