*Newport Boulevard and Hospital Road- Caltrans Project

Caltrans construction is scheduled at the following locations:

- 1) Newport Boulevard and Hospital Road during the working hours of 7:00PM-5:00AM until March 2024
- 2) Southbound Newport Blvd. south of Hospital Road during the working hours of 9AM-4PM.

*Pacific Coast Highway Caltrans Construction (Jamboree-Santa Ana River)

Caltrans construction is scheduled on Pacific Coast Highway between Jamboree Road to the Santa Ana River (Huntington Beach/Newport Beach City Limits) until summer 2024.

Streetlight Foundation Inspection

City contractors will be performing streetlight foundation inspection along 2 areas of the Balboa Peninsula from October 30-December 8 along with MacArthur Boulevard, San Joaquin Hills Road and San Miguel Drive from November 13-December 8. *Please see Attachment 4 for more information.*

Newport Bay Trash Interceptor

One lane closure will occur on northbound Jamboree Road from University Drive to Bayview Way for the Newport Bay Trash Interceptor Construction during the working hours of 7AM-6PM (Monday-Friday) until October 2024.

*SoCal Gas Mainline Replacement

Right lane closures will occur on eastbound University Drive from Jamboree Road to La Vida for SoCal Gas Mainline Replacement until January 16, 2024.

Concrete Replacement Program-Balboa Boulevard Alleys

City contractors are scheduled to begin alley construction along Balboa Boulevard between 32nd and 36th Street from November 13-March 2024 during the working hours of 8:00AM-4:30PM (Monday-Friday).

Superior Ave Pedestrian/Bicycle Bridge & Parking Lot Project

Construction of a new pedestrian/bicycle bridge across Superior Avenue, a new larger replacement parking lot and expansion of Sunset View park will occur at the intersection of West Coast Hwy. and Superior Ave. Working hours are from 7:00AM-4:30PM Monday-Friday.

*East Coast Highway Roadway Project (Caltrans)

Caltrans roadwork is scheduled on East Coast Highway from Newport Coast Drive to the Laguna Beach/Newport Beach City Limits until January 1, 2024.

Concrete Replacement Program-Dover Shores

City contractors are scheduled to conduct concrete replacement in the Dover Shores community from November 13-March 2024 during the working hours of 8:00AM-4:30PM (Monday-Friday). Please see Attachment 5 for more information.

*SR-73 Toll Road Closure- Newport Coast Drive

SR-73 Toll Road will be closed in both directions from Newport Coast Drive to Laguna Canyon Road (SR-133) on December 5 from 10PM-4AM. Please see Attachment 6 for more information.

Newport Beach Junior Lifeguard Building Project

The A Street Parking Lot adjacent to the Balboa Pier will be closed from September 5-January 24. Normal construction working hours are from 7:00AM-4:00PM Monday-Friday. Please see Attachment 2 for more information.

Balboa Island Water Main Replacement- Alley 406C

City contractors are scheduled to begin construction on Alley 406C with alley closures from November 14-December 5. Please see Attachment 1 for more information.

The City's contractor is scheduled to begin construction in the alley adjacent to your property. In order to facilitate construction, the alley (as shown on the reverse side) will be closed on the dates noted below:

The City is issuing temporary parking permits to each impacted property to relocate vehicles temporarily. **Only residents who will not have access to their garage will be issued permits.** Residents with temporary parking permits are allowed to park in the designated "Permit Parking Only" areas for permit holders as shown on the Parking Plan (see reverse side). Please note the effective dates shown on your permit. To obtain these parking permits, please contact the City representatives listed below and provide proof of residency:

Normal working hours are limited to 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

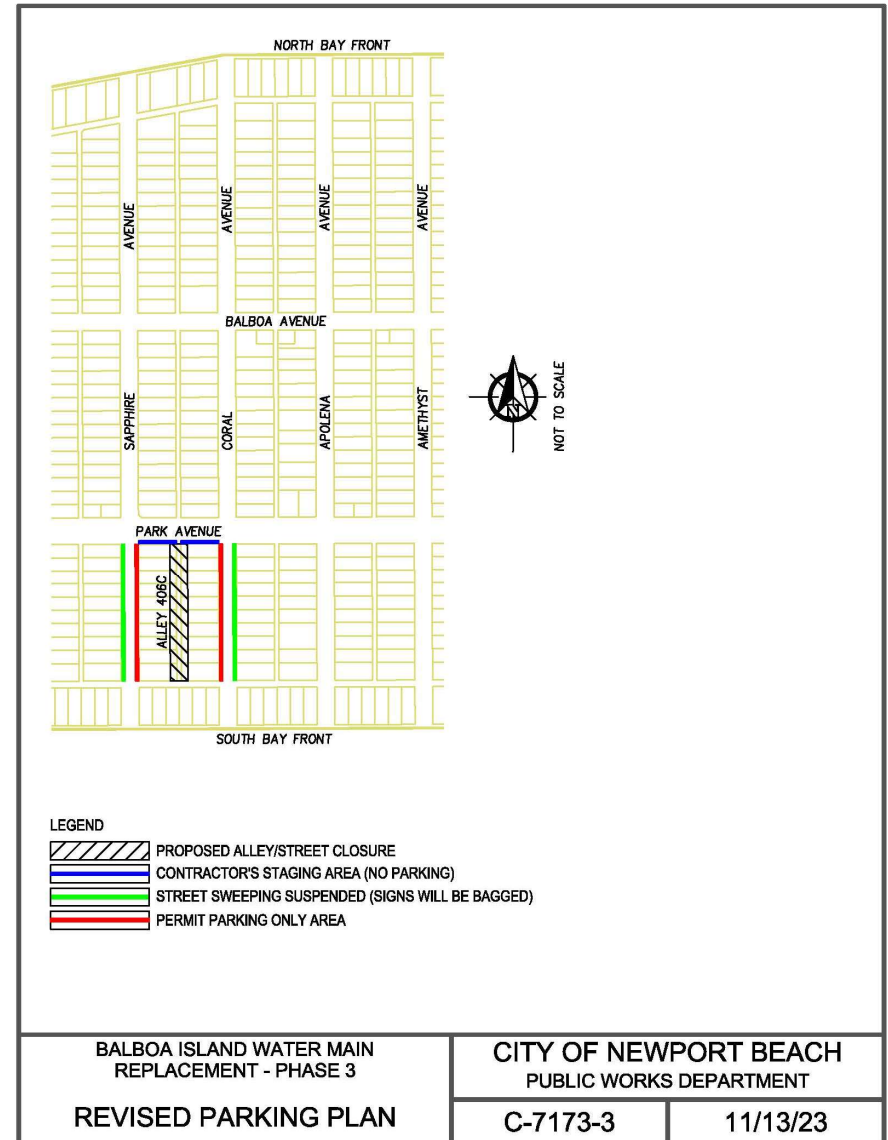

Trash pickup will continue on its normal schedule. The contractor will be responsible for coordinating trash pick-up with the City's Refuse Division and can assist in carrying your trash cans to the streets for pickup. In order to facilitate this process, we are asking residents to write their address on each trash can. **Trash receptacles must be placed outside no later than 7:00 AM for pick up.**

Dear Resident/Business Owner:

The City of Newport Beach has awarded a construction contract to TELECU Construction Management Inc., for the Newport Beach Junior Lifeguard Building Project (C 7524.2). The new Junior Lifeguard Building will replace the existing temporary facility. The affected areas will be the A Street and Main Street Parking Lots adjacent to the Balboa Pier.

The contractor will begin construction on September 05, 2023. We anticipate the opening for the new Junior Lifeguard Building will be Winter 2023. If inclement weather is encountered, the contractor is allowed additional working days to complete the work.

Normal working hours are limited to 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Should the contractor elect to work outside the normal working hours, with Engineer's approval, the times would be 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., on weekdays.

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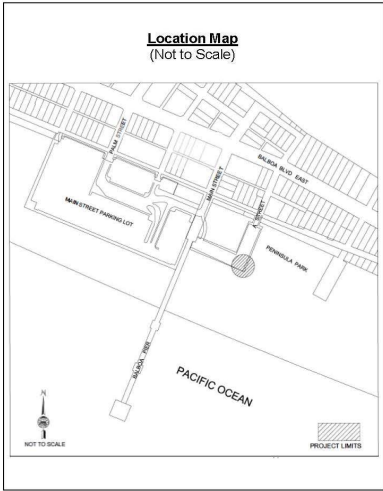

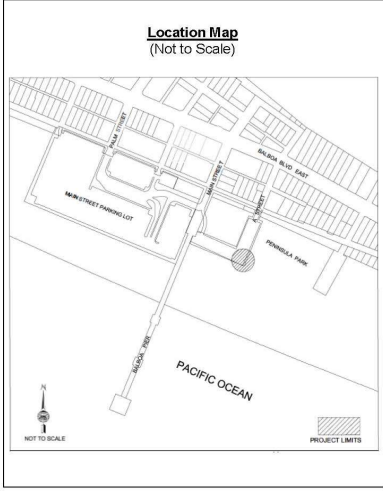

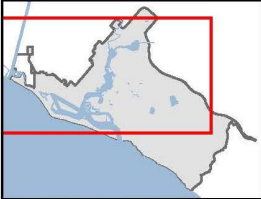


Street Light Beautification

- Signage in place to assist motorists with detours.

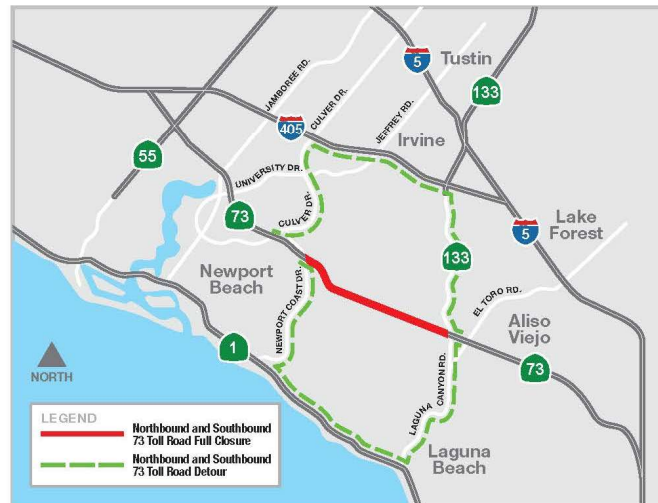
Detour for Northbound 73

Drivers will be detoured off at Newport Coast Dr. and follow signage to Pacific Coast Hwy. Turn left onto 133/Laguna Canyon Rd. and proceed to the southbound 73 entrance.
