





Construction Project with Minimal Traffic Impacts


Underground Utility Assessment District No. 124- Alley 400J and Alley 400I

The City of Newport Beach has awarded a construction contract to TELECU Construction Management linc, for the Newport Beach Junior Lifeguard Building Project (C 7524 2). The new Junior Lifeguard Building will replace the existing temporary facility. The affected areas will be the A Street and Main Street Parking Lots adjacent to the Balboa Pier.

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



East Coast Highway and San Miguel Pavement Rehabilitation C-8925-2

Dear Resident:

The City awarded a construction contract to All American Asphalt to rehabilitate East Coast Highway from Jamboree Road to MacArthur Blvd. and San Miguel Drive from Newport Center Drive to MacArthur Blvd. Refer to the reverse side for a map of the project limits.

The proposed improvements include replacing deteriorated concrete, repaving the bike trail, cold milling and overlaying the asphalt pavement, traffic signing, and striping, and utility adjustments.

Normal working hours are limited to 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The paving operation will occur at night. Night-time working hours are limited to 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning.

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

Location Map


