

## South West Map



## South East Map



Dear Resident:

The City's contractor, Vicon, is scheduled to begin construction near your property. The Hillsborough Pump Station Rehabilitation will occur during the approximate dates noted below:

8/5/24 - 9/20/24

Please comply with the posted "No Parking, Tow-Away" signs as vehicles parked within the posted area will be towed away on work days. We request that you observe these restrictions and any other traffic controls in the area. The map on the opposite side of this notice indicates the planned staging area for the contractor. Construction will only occur at the pump station, but during delivery of the pump, a crane will be in the area.

This project will be completed in two phases. The wet well installation will occur in July through September, while the gas line and generator installation will occur at the end of this year.



Balboa Blvd, Newport Blvd, and 32<sup>nd</sup> St Pavement Rehabilitation (Phase 1)

Dear Residents or Business Owners:

The City has awarded a construction contract to R.J. Noble Company to rehabilitate **Balboa Blvd** (from W. Coast Hwy to 12<sup>th</sup> St), **Newport Blvd** (from 30<sup>th</sup> St. to Balboa Blvd), and 32<sup>nd</sup> St (between Balboa Blvd and Marcus Ave). The project will be conducted in two phases. **Phase 1 will begin on June 10<sup>th</sup>**. This phase is located on Balboa Blvd between 16<sup>th</sup> St and 12<sup>th</sup> St and is anticipated to be **completed by August 16th**. Refer to the reverse side for a map of the project limits for Phase 1.

The proposed improvements include replacing deteriorated concrete, constructing pedestrian and signal improvements at the 13<sup>th</sup> St and 14<sup>th</sup> St intersections, cold milling and overlaying the asphalt pavement, installing traffic signing and striping, and adjusting utilities to grade.

Normal working hours are limited from 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Traffic restrictions at and adjacent to the work locations will be required on days that work is to be performed. "No Parking, Tow-Away" signs may be posted warning that vehicles parked within the construction area will be towed away on work days. We request that you observe these restrictions and any other traffic controls in the area.



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

**Location Map** 





# UNDERGROUND UTILITY ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 124 – PHASE 1 (CENTRAL BALBOA ISLAND)

Dear Resident:

The City's contractor is scheduled to begin construction in the alley adjacent to your property. In order to facilitate construction, the alley (as shown on the reverse side) will be closed on the dates noted below:

### 7/29/2024 to 8/16/2024

The scope of work includes, sawcutting and removal of existing pavement, trench shoring, dewatering, installing vault, underground utility main line conduits and services, pull boxes, hand holes, backfilling trench and temporary pavement replacement.


Please comply with the posted "No Parking, Tow-Away" signs as vehicles parked within the posted area will be towed away on work days. We request that you observe these restrictions and any other traffic controls in the area. No-Parking / Street Sweeping signs (as per Parking Plan on reverse side) will be bagged to allow for more on street parking for the duration of this construction. Note that once construction in your alley has been completed and the alleyway has been re-opened for your use, bags covering the No-Parking signs that front your street will be removed, street sweeping will continue its regular schedule and parking will be enforced.

Trash pickup will continue on its normal schedule. The contractor will be responsible for coordinating trash pickup with the City's Refuse Division and can assist in carrying your trash cans to the streets for pickup. In order to facilitate this process, we are asking residents to write their address on each trash can. **Trash receptacles must** be placed outside in the alley no later than 7:00 AM for pick up.

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



# Overnight Construction to Begin on Pacific Coast Highway (SR-1) in Newport Beach on August 12

**Orange County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is scheduled to begin a pavement rehabilitation project on State Route 1 (SR-1, Pacific Coast Highway) in Newport Beach starting Monday, August 12 through mid-October. The project limits include northbound and southbound SR-1 between Jamboree Road and the northern Newport Beach city limit (Santa Ana River). Work is expected to be conducted overnight weekdays, Monday through Friday, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Please note there may be loud noise due to construction. Please obey all posted signs and traffic instructions for the safety of all workers and motorists. Electronic changeable messages signs will notify drivers of the closures. The work schedule is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and/or construction-related issues.
