He has even shared his dream of one day becoming a police officer.

Despite their struggles, Jasmine and her family have shown resilience and perseverance. Living with their grandfather, a long-time Newport Beach resident since the 1950s, Jasmine ensures her children's school attendance, academics, and overall outlook remain strong. However, the family faces financial hardships that make it difficult to enjoy the comforts many take for granted during the holiday season.

When asked about her family's needs for the holidays, Jasmine humbly requested food and clothing. The Fire Santa Program is committed to going beyond these basic needs to provide the Gallant family with a Christmas they will never forget.

This beloved program began 19 years ago with the simple goal of delivering Christmas cheer to local Newport Beach families through gifts, trees, decorations, and festive meals. Over time, the program has evolved to address greater needs, including home remodels, grocery support, job placement assistance, and paying off medical bills or rent to prevent eviction. Each year, the Newport Beach Firefighters Association also provides a financial gift to help the family start the new year with hope and stability.

"Our Fire Santa Program embodies the spirit of service and community," said Firefighter Paramedic Cory Freeman. "This year, with the support of our generous residents and local businesses, we are humbled and honored to help Jasmine, and her children experience the joy and stability they deserve this holiday season."
