

Major Project with Road Closures / Detours




Landfill Project





CORTE PORTAL WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT Contract No. 7173-3

Dear Resident:

The City's contractor is scheduled to begin construction in the street adjacent to your property. In order to facilitate construction, the street (as shown on the reverse side) will be closed for a few days at a time during the dates noted below:

1/21/2025 to 1/31/2025

The scope of work includes, sawcutting and removal of existing pavement, removing and disposing of existing deteriorated cast iron water mains, installing new PVC water mains, water services and meter boxes, backfilling trench and pavement replacement.


Normal working hours are limited to 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Please comply with the posted "No Parking, Tow-Away" signs as vehicles parked within the posted area will be towed away on work days. We request that you observe these restrictions and any other traffic controls in the area. The contractor will attempt to maintain access to all driveways but at times may become inaccessible to complete the work. Water service interruptions will be required to tie the new water main to the existing water distribution main on Corte Portofino and to install new water services, meters and meter boxes. Please note that you will receive advanced "Water Shut-Off" notices from the City's Utilities Department for all planned water shut-offs.

Trash pickup will continue its normal schedule. The contractor will be responsible for coordinating trash pick-up with the City's Refuse Division and can assist in carrying your trash cans around work location zones for pickup.

Exercise caution when driving and/or walking through the construction zones. Additionally, heavy equipment and construction materials tend to attract the interest of small children. Balboa Blvd, Newport Blvd, and 32nd St Pavement Rehabilitation (Phase 2)

Dear Residents and Business Owners:

The City awarded a construction contract to R.J. Noble Company to rehabilitate Balboa Blvd, Newport Blvd, and 32nd St. The project is being conducted in two phases; Phase 1 is substantially complete, Phase 2 is currently in progress with concrete and utility improvements ongoing. Refer to the reverse side for a map of the project limits.

To maintain traffic flow, the paving operation will be completed during daytime and nighttime hours. Balboa Blvd between 16th St and 24th St and Newport Blvd between 21st and 30th St will be paved at night from October 13 (Sunday night) to October 18 (Friday morning). We anticipate completing these segments in five nights. Nighttime working hours are limited from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Balboa Blvd, from 24th St to PCH, and 32nd St, from Balboa Blvd to Marcus Ave, will be paved in the day from October 21 to November 8.

Traffic restrictions at and adjacent to the work locations will be required on working days. "No Parking, Tow-Away" signs may be posted to warn vehicles parked within the construction area during work hours may be towed away. Streets may be temporarily closed or have restricted access while work is being performed. Detour signing and/or traffic control measures will be provided to assist with navigating through or around the construction area. We kindly ask that you observe and follow any traffic controls or restrictions.





Superior Avenue and Hospital Road Pavement Rehabilitation

Dear Residents and Business Owners:

The City has awarded a construction contract to R.J. Noble Company to rehabilitate **Superior Avenue** (from W. Coast Hwy to Placentia Ave) and **Hospital Road** (from Placentia Ave to Newport Blvd). Refer to the reverse side for a map of the project limits.

The proposed improvements include replacing deteriorated concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, and curb and gutter, cold milling and overlaying the asphalt pavement, installing traffic signing and striping, adjusting utilities to grade, and installing new landscaping to the median island on Superior Ave.

Normal working hours are limited from 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Paving operations may occur at night.

Traffic restrictions at and adjacent to the work locations will be required on days that work is to be performed. "No Parking, Tow-Away" signs may be posted warning that vehicles parked within the construction area will be towed away on work days. 

Location Map







The scope of work for Alley 407C includes, providing traffic control, repairing broken sections of the existing sewer main, cleaning existing sewer mains to remove any blockages or debris, lining the existing deteriorated sewer main, cutting laterals, and final inspection to ensure the repairs are complete and the sewer main is functioning properly.

Please note that this notice also includes traffic controls currently in place for the SCE vault construction located on Diamond Avenue near the South Bay Front area. In addition to the traffic controls for the vault construction, the sewer work will require closing Park Avenue between Diamond Avenue and Sapphire Avenue for the eastbound lane only. 


