

ORANGE COUNTY HOUSING COMMISSION-ADVISORY COMMITTEE

AUTHORIZATION: Re-established by Orange County Housing Commission on May 31, 1982, by Resolution No. 4-82. City of Newport Beach representatives appointed by City Council minute action.

MEMBERSHIP: One City staff representative and alternate appointed by the Mayor, to serve for two years.

TERM: Indefinite

PURPOSE & RESPONSIBILITIES: Each participating jurisdiction is invited to have one voting representative and an alternate to serve as a direct link between the 23 participating jurisdictions and the Housing Commission.

The Advisory Committee will consider and recommend on such matters as applications for Section 8 Existing units, suballocation of rental assistance to meet local Housing Assistance Plan goals, and proposals for new or expanded programs to meet needs of lower income households in the County.

To act as liaison between the respective participating jurisdictions and the Orange County Housing Authority and to act in an advisory capacity to the OCHA Housing Commission in matters of policy pertaining to housing programs and long range housing goals and other matters as determined by the Housing Commission.
